CRIMES

A BRAWL AT THE INKWELL resulted in several injuries, as well as extensive damage to the common

MAYHEM IN HELSGRAD

Riots continue unabated in Helsgrad this week. A group of laborers have taken control of the Paslosk Mine to the south of the city, shutting down operations there.

AN UNUSUAL OFFERING

A friend of mine recently directed me to the shop of Ideya Vanyushin at 78CD. Miss Vanyushin is a very clever young woman who practices a very unusual art she described to our paper as 'bonesmithing'.

Miss Vanyushin's shop is decorated with all manner of beautiful trinkets and strange carvings made from the bones of various creatures. When I first saw her wares, I was shocked by the complexity of design and the sheer variety of the objects she had

made.
