### **CRIMES**

An incident of public violence and suspected arson was recorded at the Toad & the Spider. Agatha Roth is being held in connection with the crime, and will be tried in the Court of the Heron.

Authorities are looking for any information on the whereabouts of her siblings, Helene and Sigfried Roth, to determine whether or not they had any foreknowledge of the attack.

A woman was found murdered in the Skraemarket outside 52GD. The reason for the attack is unclear, but authorities do not believe robbery was the motive.

A horse was stolen from a stable in the Common Market by a man in a dress; one of the stableboys tried to stop the man and was badly beaten.

The thief is described as having blue eyes, dark red hair, and a thick beard; he appeared to be drunk at the time of the attack.

The offices of Möller and Penz were broken into last week; the famed chemists are presently traveling, but their apprentice Pavas Vateshky was knocked unconscious in the attack.

Authorities seek information on either the perpetrator or possible motives for the robbery, as nothing of exceptional value was taken.

### TERROR AT THE TOAD & SPIDER

Chaos erupted this past week after an explosion at The Toad & Spider killed six, including the playwright Mir Alenin and his muse, Elizaveta Volkov.

The owner of the establishment, Mark Bagger, as well as one of the patrons, Harald Casterwatch, were injured in the fire while attempting to rescue guests trapped on the 2nd and 3rd floors of the inn. Witnesses report that survivors of the blaze were attacked by a waiting assassin, since identified as Agatha Ross. Miss Roth is a decorated veteran who fought in the war under Lord Hasturmark at Barrowman's March and Sigmund's Folly.

The deadly brawl echoes the fight last month which left seven dead, including Olvar Demidov and Trina Ilutskaya, sworn officers of the watch. Authorities apprehended Roth as she pursued her quarry on the Street of Sails toward Prospekt Nemitskaya. The officers credited with her capture are Serge Ghast and Rodion Egorov.

Roth is being held at the Averport Quarterhouse while she awaits trial at the Court of the Heron. She is charged with disorderly conduct, sixteen counts of murder, one count of willful destruction of private property, and several miscellaneous charges associated with the fire. Authorities are actively looking for Ivan Skravsky, who bore witness to the prior fray outside The Toad & Spider, so that he can confirm Miss Roth's role in the death of Demidov and Ilutskaya.

Also of interest to authorities are the three individuals who they believe were targeted by Miss Roth as they emerged from the fire.

Cmdr. Sovechsky of the Averport Quarterhouse stresses that three individuals who were attacked are currently being regarded as victims, and have been vouched for by upstanding citizens throughout the Grebsky District.

They are advised to report to the Crimson Keep immediately so that
