### CRIMES

A number of thefts were reported along the Street of Cinders; victims report gold, jewelry, and other items were stolen from their person. Any citizens with information are asked to report to Officer Bartol Hasserstrom at 32MR.

### CONTROVERSIAL FINISH

A second year of controversy as Gideon Müller's Cogsmen back the Turners in city elections, keeping both the Mirror of Dawn and Brass Dragons foundries locked out of control over the city.

Last year, Lucy Dressler's Turners backed the Cogsmen, and were in turn rewarded with critical positions throughout the city's bureaucracy; the alliance threatens to undermine democratic norms in the city, as both foundries poach promising new recruits and violate term limits by trading power in this method.

Without any representation in the bureaucracy, other foundries are often disadvantaged when it comes to scheduling and permitting; there are rumors that scheduling delays led to the Turners' deal to supply cannons and arms to Volgstadt's Merchant League, and Vatengrad's shipyards, contracts which the Brass Dragons had held for years.

### LORD IVARR KILLED AT SEA

Reports from the south indicate that Lord Ivarr Vostrovich was killed at sea while battling savrathi reavers to the south of Bosk. Lord Ivarr was a staunch ally of the Merchant League in Volgstadt, and a tireless defender of the Western Reach.

Crimson Winter and Ironcross were said to have engaged a quarter of warships in the islands off the coast, and appeared to have caught the reavers by surprise after preparing an ambush for them.

Survivors indicated that Lord Ivarr and his men were fighting off a boarding action by one of the reaver vessels when a stray shot from *Ironcross* struck the reaver ship's magazine and caused her to explode.

Lord Hasturmark and his men were able to rescue many of the survivors from *Crimson Winter* after finishing the reavers in decisive fashion, with three of the four ships put to the torch and the fourth wrecked in the shoals of the islands south of Bosk.

Lord Vostrovich's heir, Solzen Vostrovich, has been traveling with an expedition from the Explorator's League of Volgstadt for the past two years and is not expected to return to Vastengrad until early next summer.

Lady Vostrovich is expected to act as regent in her son's absence; Lady Vostrovich, of course, is known for her writings on the importance of

free trade and can be expected to continue her husband's policies with respect to open commerce between the Western Reaches and the lands of Old Volgvarra.

## MIRACULOUS NEW FUEL

The famed chemists Moller & Penz were in Streissberg this month to receive an award from the Conclave of the Iron Court.

Rounds of intense negotiations over the formula for the new fuel came to a close when the pair decided to sell it to Helmut Vulker, Forgemaster of the Mirror of Dawn.

Competition for access to the fuel was intense, with some reporting that Lucy Dressler of the Turners offered a lifetime pension and a sum in the area of eight thousand volgs simply for non-exclusive access.

Terms of the deal are sealed, but it is believed that the Mirror of Dawn will have exclusive rights for at least the next five years; the cries of despairing engineers could be heard from across the city at the news. A series of closed tests show that the fuel's efficiency could radically change the economic viability of steamships.

Gideon Müller of the Cogsmen is said to have been particularly distraught, as the fuel was thought to be potentially revolutionary for his theorized land-train machine.

# IRON SHORTAGE

Iron shipments from Sprevitch, which were expected to begin early this summer, have been delayed by the outbreak of barrow chigs and einvorms in the Brachenvauld.

Shipments are expected to resume as soon as possible, but travel in the Brachenvauld is being strongly discouraged by local authorities; reports of missing townsfolk in Buristovok, Volcha, and Yvili.

In addition to the delay in shipments from Sprevitch, production is down in Helsgrad after the riots there.
